## MONDAY SELECTIONS, BETTING STRATEGY AND PICK 4 TICKET

Sunday Results: Hit 2 top choice winners but went 0-for-2 (one scratch) on my Best Plays.

Today's Best Plays: Races 6, 8, 10 and a $\$ 72$ Pick 4 ticket. Also, with the $\$ 1$ million guaranteed Pick Six pool, I will give out a $\$ 96$ suggested P6 play.

I like the way MCNASTY (6-1) won here early in the meet and now gets a confident three-level class boost for this. The lightly-raced 6 -year-old has some back class in his corner and should fall into a great spot behind the speed horses. Make a Win Bet on MCNASTY and key him in the trifecta over SMOKIN FOREST (7-2), OCEANUS (6-1) and SUNDAY NAP (5-1) for second, then use ALL for third. Play a second ticket using those three on top, with MCNASTY for second, then ALL.

INSTANT ACTION (5-2) was super well-meant first time out but got run down late in a very highly-rated runner-up try. The Koriner-trained colt gets a major rider upgrade to Gryder and again is drawn well outside. I will play the trifecta keying 'ACTION over five horses in the second and third spots: CATCH THAT THIEF/LATIN RHYTHMS (5-1 entry), I'M ALL OUT (5-1), WHY YOU ASK (3-1), MONTEREY JAZZ (6-1) and CHANCELLOR (20-1). Also, play a second ticket using those five in the first and third spots, with 'ACTION in the middle.
Trifecta numbers: $\mathbf{1 2} / \mathbf{1 , 2 , 4 , 5 , 9 / 1 , 2 , 4 , 5 , 9 = \$ 2 0}$ and $\mathbf{1 , 2 , 4 , 5 , 9 / 1 2 / 1 , 2 , 4 , 5 , 9 = \$ 2 0}$

In a very competitive nightcap, I will make a Win Bet on my top choice and play the exacta and trifecta by boxing my top four selections. IRONSTAR (6-1) shortens up and drops in class after chasing a wicked pace going long last time. He adds blinkers, has trained well and might like the cut back in distance. In the exacta/trifecta, use QUIET PERIOD (10-1), who turned in an even effort vs. much stronger down the hill; IRONSTAR (6-1); PAPAGO ROAD (7-2), coming off a third-place finish at this level; and DIXIE BANKER (3-1), who has been facing much stronger.
